REQUIREMENTS OF DAVID HUBBELL CONCERTO COMPETITION

Eligibility:

- Previous competition winners are not eligible.
- The composition to be performed must be approved by the ACYO Conductor.

Application Procedure:

- <u>Due Date</u>: Emailed applications must be submitted to: <u>glangford@arts.ufl.edu</u> by 5:00 pm on Tuesday January 31, 2023.
- <u>Application Fee</u>: A \$25 fee must be submitted with the application. Payment may be paid online at <u>acyo.org/competitions</u>. Checks may be mailed to P.O. Box 358023, Gainesville FL 32635-8023 and must be postmarked by Tuesday, January 31, 2023. This fee will be refunded if the composition to be performed is not approved by the ACYO Conductor.
- <u>Audition Acceptance Notification</u>: All applicants will receive an email notification of their audition acceptance along with their assigned audition time.

Audition:

- <u>Date</u>: February 25, 2023, starting at 1:00 pm.
- Location: University of Florida, Music Building, Room 101
- <u>Expectations</u>:
 - Applicant will perform from memory one movement of a concerto or up to two arias or songs.
 - Applicant will provide the judges with one copy of the music performed.
 - Audition performance time will be limited to the length of time entered on the application.
 - Applicant will provide his/her own accompanist, as needed.
 - \circ $\;$ Applicants will be given their adjudication forms after the audition.

Winner:

- The winner* will be announced at the conclusion of the auditions.
- All applicants will be notified of the results by email within one week of the audition.
- Winner will be selected based on points received form the panel of judges.
- The winner will perform the audition piece with the ACYO during its spring concert scheduled for **Sunday, April 28, 2024 at 7:00 pm** in the University Auditorium at the University of Florida

*Judges need not declare a winner. The ACYO Conductor will be available to the judges for consultation during the selection process as needed.
