REQUIREMENTS OF DAVID HUBBELL CONCERTO COMPETITION



Eligibility:

- Previous competition winners are not eligible.
- The composition to be performed must be approved by the ACYO Conductor.

Application Procedure:

- Due Date: Emailed applications must be submitted to: dregraham@gmail.com by 5:00 pm on Sunday January 18, 2026.
- Application Fee: A \$30 fee must be submitted with the application. Payment may be paid online at acyo.org/competitions. This fee will be refunded if the composition to be performed is not approved by the ACYO Conductor.
- Audition Acceptance Notification: All applicants will receive an email notification of their audition acceptance along with their assigned audition time.

Audition:

- Date: Saturday, January 24th, 2026, beginning at 1pm.
- Location: University of Florida, Music Building, Room 101
- Expectations:
 - Applicant will perform from memory one movement of a concerto or up to two arias or songs.
 - Applicant will provide the judges with one copy of the music performed.
 - Audition performance time will be limited to the length of time entered on the application.
 - Applicant will provide his/her own accompanist, as needed.
 - Applicants will be given their adjudication forms after the audition.

Winner:

- The winner* will be announced at the conclusion of the auditions.
- All applicants will be notified of the results by email within one week of the audition.
- Winner will be selected based on points received from the panel of judges.
- The winner will perform the audition piece with the ACYO during its spring concert scheduled for **Sunday, April 26, 2025 at 7:00 pm** at the University of Florida

*Judges need not declare a winner. The ACYO Conductor will be available to the judges for consultation during the selection process as needed.
